

## HOLIDAY LAPS INFORMATION

- The gates open to the public at 7:30am and the first group will go on track at 8:30am. 1.
- 2. Every driver must attend the mandatory drivers briefing before taking the track.
- 3. Each session is \$25 in money, unwrapped toys or non-perishable food items. Additional sessions can be purchased in the North Paddock if there is time for to get into additional groups.
- 4. Checks can be accepted, but must be made payable to: Danville, VA Salvation Army.
- The first 300 cars will receive one (1) coupon for a free 5x7 color photo from F & S Enterprises. The 5. photo must be picked on-site the day of the event.
- 6. There will be a one-hour lunch break so that Corner Workers can have time to eat.
- There is a possibility of buying hot lap rides in some cars. All proceeds go to the Salvation Army. 7. (Children will be allowed to participate in a ride-a-long provided that they safely fit into one of the provided

## **HOLIDAY LAPS RULES**

- 1. Every driver must attend the mandatory drivers briefing before taking the track
- 2. No passing is allowed during the session
- 3. No one is allowed to stop or change drivers
- 4. No laying back (Maintain 2-4 car length distance)
- 5. Each session will have a pace car and a chase car
- 6. You will exit the false grid to pit road onto the track
  - A. Or Identify alternate entrance/exit
  - B. Identify the location of the checkered flag
- 7. All vehicle occupants will wear a safety belt
- 8. Make sure all items in your vehicle are secured
- 9. No cell phone use by the driver
- 10. If you break down, pull over to the right side of the track and wait for assistance. Do not exit your vehicle until EMS arrives and tells you it is safe to do so.
